LO Students will participate in activities they select as being representative of 'favourite playground games' within their school.

LO Using photos and pictures, students will send an outline of these games to children in China so they can attempt to play similar games.

Activity 1:

Olympa-Groove using 'We Are Ready'

Focus Question:

If we were going to take some of our favourite school games to share with children in a school in China, what would we take to show them?

Teacher note:

Students choose two games often played in their school i.e. tag games, padder tennis etc (does not have to be formal sport – use sparc website (<u>www.sparc.co.nz</u>) and kiwidex if necessary.

Activity 2:

Play and photos

Play both games and remind children of key rules and purpose. Take photos of children playing these games

Activity 3: Writing task
